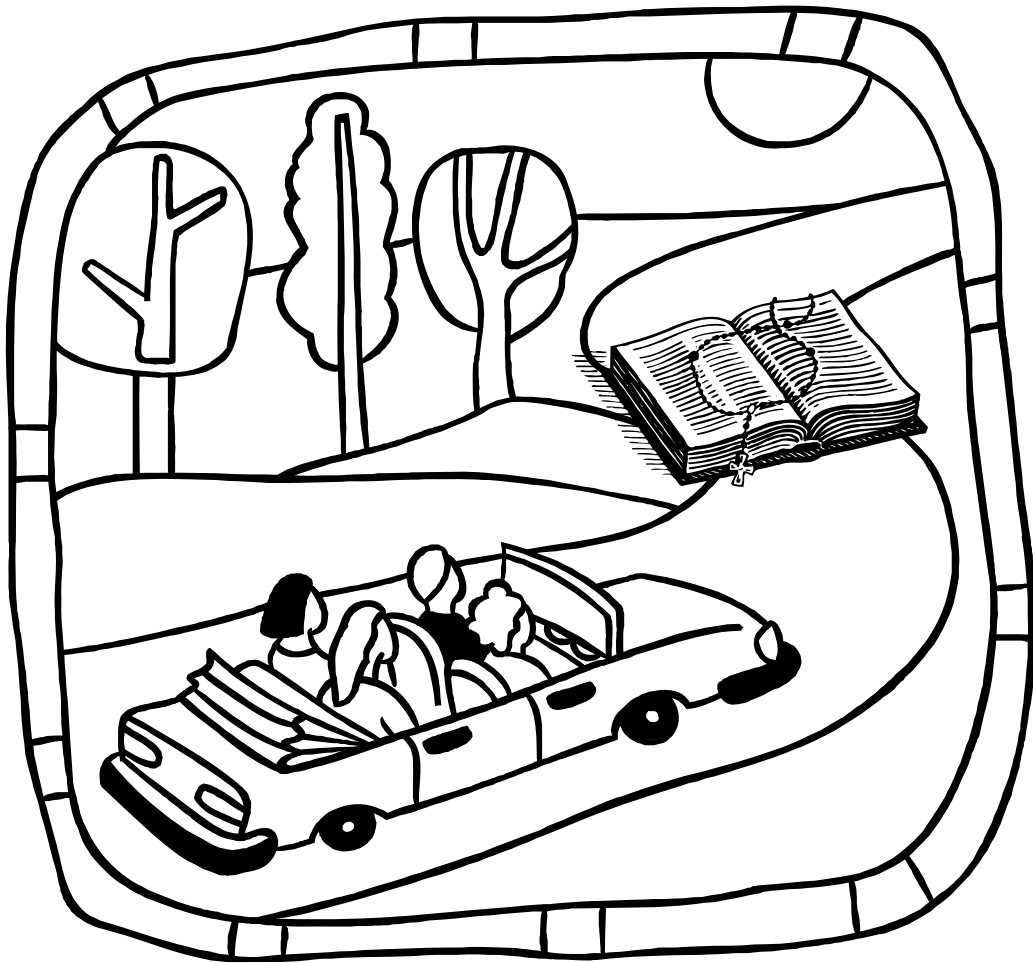

## Bible Trivia & Fun

Just open up a Bible and test each other's knowledge. How many books have just 4 letters? How many books have just one chapter? How many chapters are in a particular book? Think of a book (or person, place...) and then give clues until someone figures it out. Pick a scripture and see if people can remember where it is in the Bible. Create an acronym for something in the Bible and see if someone can guess it (i.e.- TTIM= This too is meaningless or MOO= Mount of Olives). Or create your own variation of Bible trivia or Bible fun.

## Bible Names

This is a variation of one I remember playing when we traveled. One person names a place or a person found in the Bible. **Using the last letter** of their person or place name, the next person must do the same. The same person or place name cannot be used more than once. *Here's an example then of how a game might go: Israel, Lebanon, Nahum, Molech, Hezekiah, Haman, Nazareth, Hur, Rahab, Etc...*

## T-O-A-S-T

This is a variation of an old game called "GHOST" and if you've got one, a concordance will come in handy. The first player chooses a letter of the alphabet and each player after that adds one letter until a word or name of four letters or more which can be found in the Bible is made. Whenever a player gives a letter they must have a legitimate word in mind. For example, if player 1 gives the letter "Z", player 2 can't give letter "q" because no word could then be formed. Whoever completes the word loses the round and receives a letter, starting with "T," then "O," then "A" (like in a game of "HORSE") until the word TOAST is spelled. At that point, the player with TOAST is, well, toast ☺ (out of the game). The remaining players continue until all but one player have received all five letters of TOAST. If you know you're about to say a letter that spells a word, you can bluff using a letter that does not spell a word. The next player can continue spelling the "word" or they can challenge them. If no word can be formed using the letter they added, then the bluffer get a letter. But if a Bible word or name can still be spelled, then the challenger gets the letter.

Example: P1 – D, P2 – R (DR), P3 – E (DRE), P4 – A (DREA)... Now player 1 (in 4 player game) will either have to spell "dream" (or "dread") or bluff. Sometimes it can be trickier:

P1 – O, P2 - F (OF), P3 – F (OFF), P4 – E (OFFE) ... Now, if player 1 is thinking, they won't spell "offer" but instead... P1 – N (OFFEN)... Player 2 doesn't want to spell "offend", so... P2 – S (OFFENS)... Player 2 avoids spelling "offense" by giving an "i"... (OFFENSI). That would leave player 3 to add a "v" (OFFENSIV) leaving P4 with the word (OFFENSIVE) or with a pointless bluff. ☺

## ABC Fun

This game requires a good knowledge of the Bible and a good memory. Start with any letter in the alphabet and quote a verse or part of a verse that starts with a word that starts with that letter. Then the other players have to quote a verse or part of a verse that start with a word that starts with the next letter. Here's a partial example using the letter "I":

Person 1: "If my people, who are called by name..." (2 Chronicles 7:14)  
Next person: "Jesus wept." (John 11:35)  
Next: "Kiss the son, lest he be angry." (Psalm 2:12)  
Next: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart..." (Deuteronomy 6:5)  
Next: "My God my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46)  
Next: "Not to us, but to your name be the glory." (Psalm 115:1)

... and so on. The players can decide how much of a verse needs to be quoted and how much time to allow for thinking. See if you can make it all the way through the alphabet and keep quotes coming. (You'll can also choose to skip over hard letters like "x" and "z". ☺)

## The Initials Game

OK, so there's nothing Bible-related about this one, but this game is great fun! The object is to give the other person clues with words that use the initials of the person you want them to guess. For example: "Electric Pelvis" could be used to describe Elvis Presley or "Fuzzy Communist" to describe Fidel Castro, or "Blonde Singer" for Britney Spears, etc.

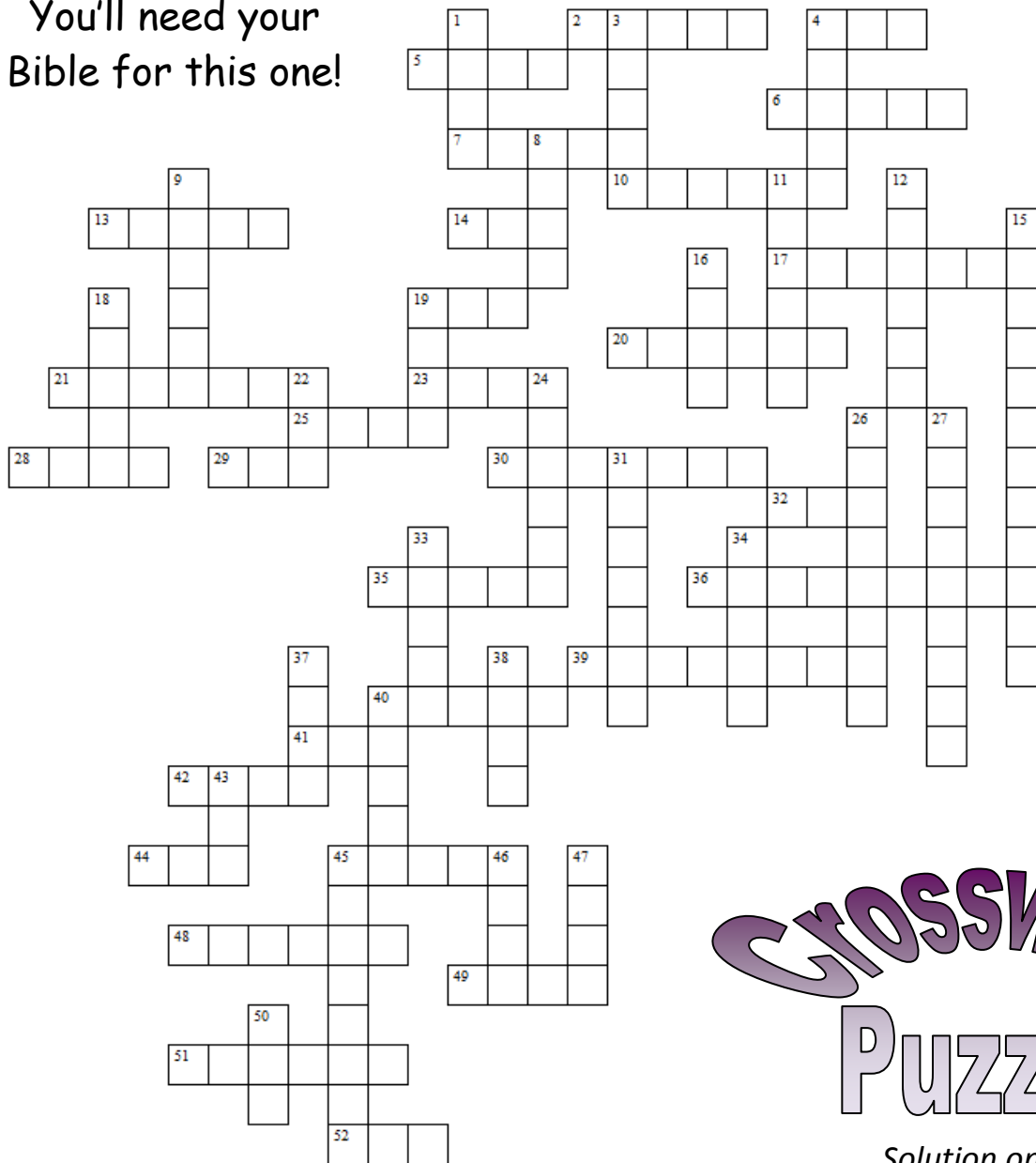

In fact, some find themselves in a jam, especially since the names aren't capitalized and punctuation can make it hard to judge some. 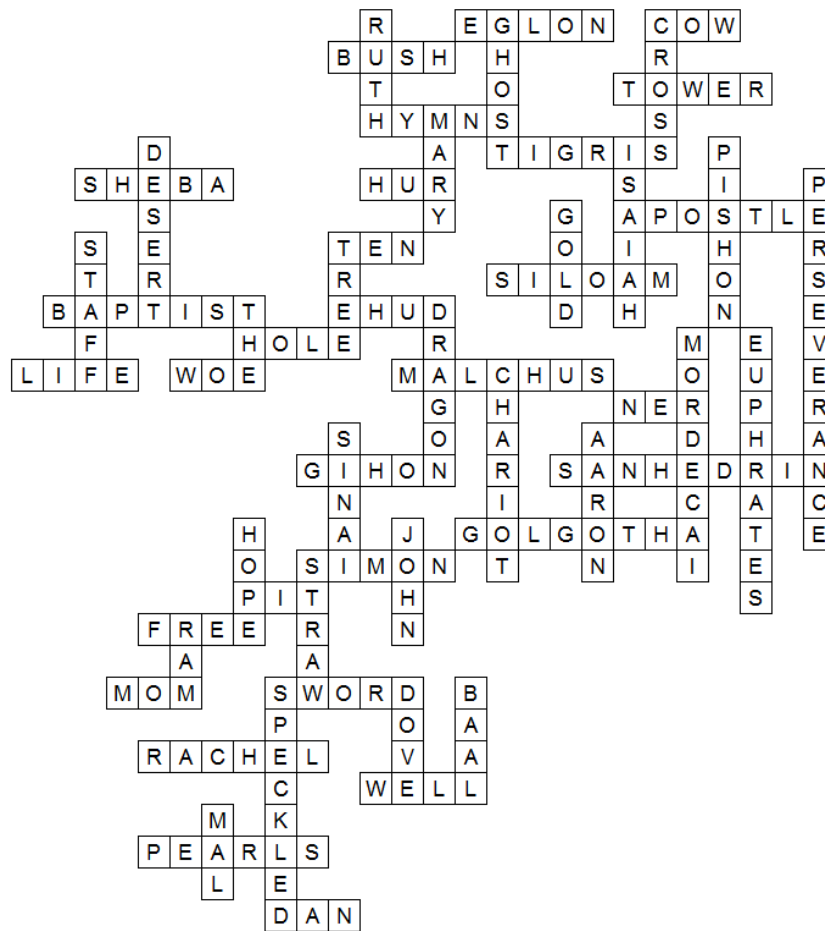

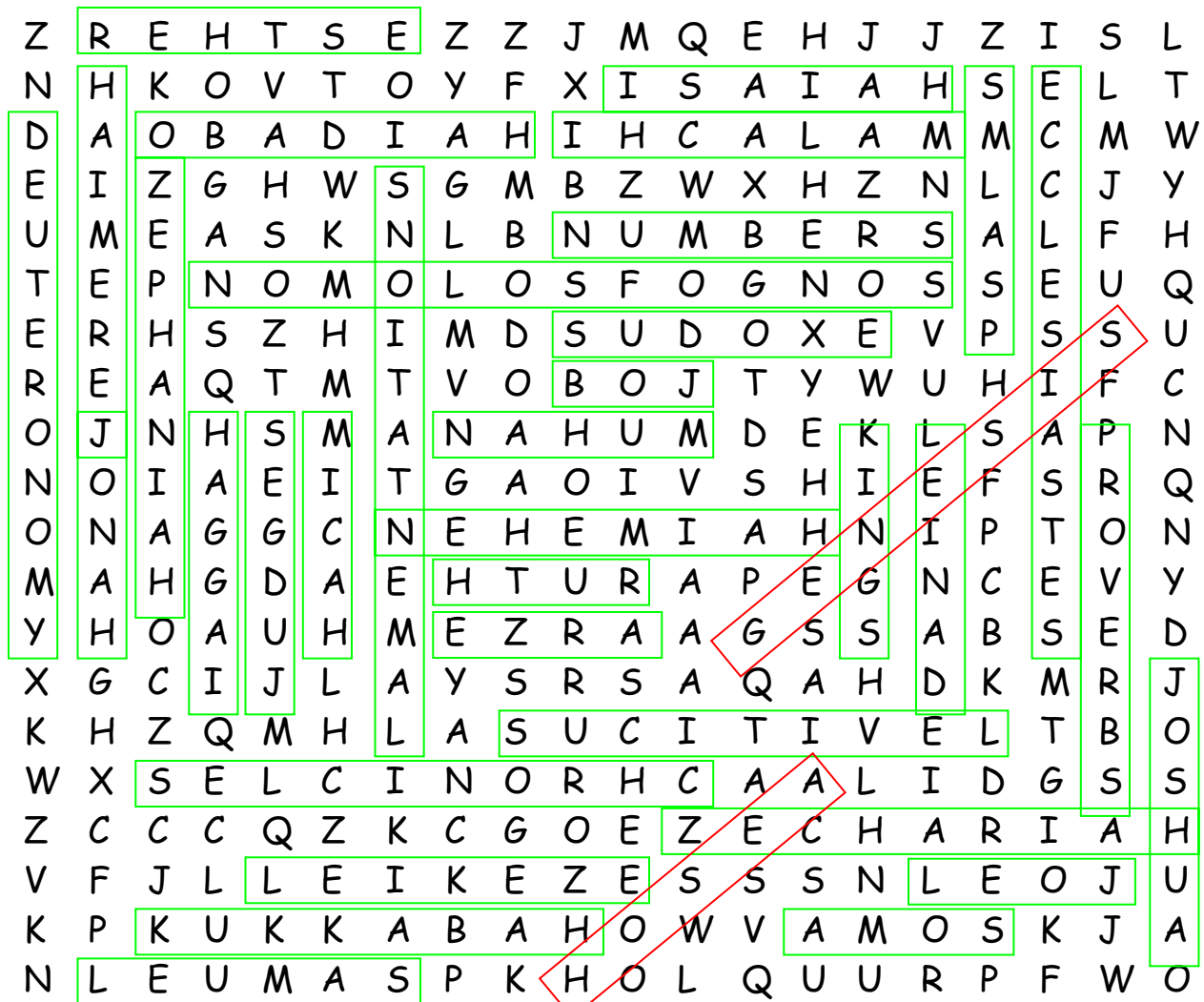
